

Pieces for Peace Traveling Exhibition

CITYarts Thinking Globally - Acting Locally

CITYarts is producing *Pieces for Peace Mosaic with Youth from around the World*. This project is designed to build bridges of cultural understanding by bringing American children and their peers from around the globe together to design and create an **online mosaic** comprised of 6"x6" tile-size drawings, paintings and poems. These elements are being incorporated into a permanent, large-scale **outdoor mosaic** in Harlem, New York City. A **traveling exhibition** has been on display at Flushing Town Hall in Queens as part of the Freedom Festival and will be shown from May 18th 2005 – June 13, 2005 at The Cork Gallery, Avery Fisher Hall, 65th St & Broadway, Manhattan, NY, USA.

About the Traveling Exhibition:
