Alice on the Wall Restoration

A CITYarts mural project in Tribeca, Manhattan

What:

CITYarts will Restore and recreate the *Alice on the Wall* mural on Chambers St. near Stuyvesant High School. This mural was originally created after 9/11 to encourage students at Stuyvesant to return to school. Now, every few years a new generation of students make it their duty to restore the mural and to add their voices. In this restoration, students from StuyCanvas, an art club, and the South Asian Media and Entertainment club reached out to CITYarts with the idea for a collaboration. They will be working with the alumni association to develop and share ideas as they restore and redesign parts of their beloved *Alice on the Wall*. CITYarts and NYPD collaboration will invite police officers for students to get to know them in a safe environment.
