

**Pieces for Peace Project CITYarts 50 States of Peace Initiative**  CITYarts' Young Minds Build Bridges Program, with youth around the world, was created following the tragic events of September 11, 2001. Following the harsh reality of the pandemic years, we feel a need to unite our youth in the 50 States as well. Starting with a one-hour-long art workshop, CITYarts Pieces of Peace give youth a voice to build bridges of cultural understanding and bring them into contact and dialogue with each other through making art, displaying art in exhibitions, and creating permanent Peace Walls, making a lasting impact in their communities as leaders of today and legends of tomorrow.

CITYarts 50 States of Peace consists of five parts and is recommended for youth aged 12-20. You can do one of the steps or all!

### 1. WORKSHOPS



Youth from around the 50 States will participate in one-hour-long workshops in which they create that answer question: "What does peace look like to me?"

To date, CITYarts has received over 10,000 artworks from over 1,400 schools and community organizations in 120 countries on 6 continents. Now we go National to unite for peace.

### 2. ONLINE MOSAIC WALL







## 3. PEACEPALS



Youth who have created an artwork can explore our Online Exhibition and they can **exchange their** visions of peace with another youth participant through our PeacePals Initiative, bringing them into contact and dialogue with each other through the creation of art.

## 4. TRAVELING EXHIBITION



You may host CITYarts' Traveling Exhibition of 300 Pieces for Peace artworks by youth from around the world. Your students' Pieces for Peace artworks will hang alongside our exhibition. Invite the community to come and celebrate the visions of peace.

# 5. PEACE WALLS



In collaboration with a professional artist, your school, other schools in your city, and with community members, the ideas formulated in the CITYarts Pieces for Peace workshop will inspire the Peace Wall - a permanent mural to be painted on a selected wall in the community.

We hope that youth will "hold hands" around the 50 States and the world through their Pieces for Peace visions, which are now in 120 countries and 15 states. More and more pieces will be created during our ongoing workshops, giving youth a visual voice through the creation of permanent Peace Walls with local youth and artists. Our exhibition will continue to travel and grow as it visits more locations nationally and internationally. It will activate children's minds to become positive contributors in shaping the future in all 193 countries under the United Nations' flag and through CITYarts 50 States of Peace Initiative, we hope that one Peace Wall will be created in each state.
